

Knoxville/Knox County Recycling Guide

Single Stream

- ◆ Plastics
 - ◆ Containers #1-7, cups, bottles, milk/juice/detergent jugs & caps, keep lids on
- ◆ Metals
 - ◆ Aluminum, steel & tin cans
- ◆ Mixed Paper
 - ◆ Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, cereal boxes, sticky notes, envelopes, notebooks, office paper, cardboard, paperboard & shredded paper
- ◆ Leave items loose in bins

Recycling Drop Off Centers

- ◆ Plastics
 - ◆ Containers #1-7, cups, bottles, milk/juice/detergent jugs & caps, keep lids on
- ◆ Metals
 - ◆ Aluminum, steel & tin cans
- ◆ Mixed Paper
 - ◆ Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, cereal boxes, sticky notes, envelopes, notebooks, office paper, cardboard, paperboard & shredded paper
- ◆ Glass
 - ◆ Clear, brown, green/blue
- ◆ Reusable Household Goods
 - ◆ Only when Goodwill Attendant is present

Tips: Plastic bags and film are NOT recyclable-they can be returned to grocery stores. Items should be cleaned prior to recycling. Styrofoam is not acceptable even if it is labeled #6.
