

Tips for City Yard Service:

• Keep yard waste piles to 6'deep X 6'wide X 6'tall

 Stumps or logs larger than 12" are the owners responsibility and will not be picked up by the City (options on reverse side)

• Be sure yard waste piles are not blocking the road, mailboxes, utilities, etc.

 If you have excessive volumes, save some for the next round of pick-up

• Yard waste is collected every other week

 Be sure to keep trash and bulky items out of yard waste

 Don't bag leaves – the machines need leaves loose and un-bagged

• During leaf season (Nov.-Feb.), don't mix sticks, brush or any other debris with leaf piles





Did you know...

...tree service companies are required to remove all debris they create from your property?

It is true, and therefore, the City is not responsible for picking up their debris. Be sure your tree service is hauling off all the brush, sticks and logs as a part of their service.

...the City offers FREE Saturday at transfer station (City dump)?

City residents can take items (including excessive or oversized yard waste) to the transfer station located at 1033 Elm Street for free on the first Saturday of every month (except holiday weekends).

...the City of Knoxville repurposes yard waste?

Mulch is created from residential yard waste when set at the curb for pick-up.
